



## JOINT NOTICE OF FILING FORT McMURRAY AREA

APPLICATION BY PARSONS CREEK AGGREGATES TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND RECLAIM A LIMESTONE QUARRY.

NRCB APPLICATION NO. 1001

**TAKE NOTICE** that Parsons Creek Aggregates (PCA), a joint venture between Graymont Western Canada Inc. and Lehigh Hanson Materials Limited, has applied to the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) and Alberta Environment (AENV) for approval to construct, operate and reclaim a limestone quarry in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo (the Proposal). The proposed Project site is located on 390 ha of Crown land 800 m north of the Fort McMurray Urban Service Boundary, south of Northlands Forest Products, east of Highway 63 along the Athabasca River. The legal land description for the proposed project site includes portions of Sections 7, 8, 18, 19, 30 and 31 of Township 90, Range 9, West of the 4<sup>th</sup> Meridian, and a portion of the NE ¼ Section 36, Township 90, Range 10, West of the 4<sup>th</sup> Meridian.

### NATURE OF APPLICATION

In support of the Proposal, PCA has prepared and submitted Application No. 001-231302 to AENV under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act (EPEA)* for the construction, operation and reclamation of the proposed PCA limestone quarry and File No. 00269043 under the *Water Act (WA)* for the water management aspect of the Proposal. PCA has also prepared and submitted an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) report to AENV, which forms part of PCA's application to the NRCB.
